



Camp Cook Helper

Catering Training and Employment Opportunity

The Mount Nansen Remediation Project is seeking a cook's helper / trainee who is interested in gaining hands-on experience working alongside a head camp cook. This opportunity will allow the cook's helper to develop their cooking skills and learn about working in and managing a camp kitchen.

Mileage payment:	If driving to/from site, mileage will be paid at \$0.70/km

Type of Work

- 1. Communicate with the head cook to prepare and serve three meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) per day and snacks for a camp crew of approximately 10 to 15 people.
- 2. Work with the head cook to conduct meal planning and food ordering.
- 3. Work with the head cook to arrange for delivery of food to site.
- 4. Maintain a sanitary kitchen, food service, and dining area.
- 5. Clean dishware.

Expectations

- 1. Professionalism respectful communication, tidiness, appropriate attire, working well with others, and contributing to a team.
- 2. Adhere to all MNRLP site safety and conduct rules.
- 3. Willingness to learn and take on added responsibility.
- 4. Food Safe Level 1 certification required (MNRLP is willing to work with a prospective candidate to obtain certification if needed).

Additional Assets

- 1. Standard First Aid
- 2. Driver's Licence if you do not have a driver's licence, transportation may be arranged through LSCFN Lands Department.

Other Information

- Accommodation will be provided at the Mount Nansen bunkhouse.
- Shifts are maximum 12-hour days. It is expected the cook's helper will work a split shift involving working 6 hours in the morning and working 6 hours in the afternoon with a 2-3 hour break in between.
